1. Suite overview

The Full Option Family Office (FopFo™) suite is a unified, private family-office platform made up of five interworking applications. Each application is useful on its own and becomes more powerful in combination: holdings draw on currency pools, benefits are funded from those same pools, and the family register ties recipients to the people they belong to. The Master Enabler licenses and activates each installed application.

The suite operates across the web today, with native desktop and mobile packaging planned. It supports fifteen languages (including right-to-left Arabic and Urdu), light/dark themes and a custom background colour.

2. The five applications

Family Tree Application (Familiigi™)

A private genealogy and household register for the family office.

- Colour-coded family branches with a card view and an interactive diagram view.
- Search by name, maiden name, date of birth or date of death; highlight any descendant line.
- Spouse links, generational layout, and per-person benefit-group tagging.
- Unlimited persons; names up to 12 characters, optional maiden name with show/hide.

Holdings Management Application (BoxAlong™)

A register and valuation ledger for assets, possessions and holdings.

- Unlimited items across many categories with rich classification.
- Acquisition and disposal with costs, fees and taxes; per-item transaction ledger.
- Straight-line and declining-balance depreciation schedules with book-value projection.
- Draws on / adds to Currency pools when items are acquired or disposed.

Currency Management Application (Currencida™)

User-defined currency and value pools — fiat, mobile money, tokens and stablecoins.

- Unlimited user-defined currencies with floating rates, fees and tax.
- Live settlement between pools and the Holdings and Benefits applications.
- Per-pool balances with opening / inflow / outflow / closing statements.

Benefits Management Application (SEBAA™)

Simple, Efficient Benefits Administration — define, fund and pay benefits.

- Unlimited benefits with eligibility rules (age, gender, characteristic).
- Recipient classes/groups; dedicated or collective fund pools; tax handling.
- Actuarial / liquidity projections (horizon, escalation, discount, life-expectancy cap).
- Pays or reimburses recipients by drawing on a chosen Currency pool.

Master Enabler (Generating Application)

The licensing backbone that generates, discloses, reveals and manages activation codes.

- A unique 20-character, case-sensitive activation code per installed instance.

- Code is bound to the customer's email and phone and to a specific operating system.
- Payment-gated release; self-service code retrieval for verified, paid customers.
- Role-delegated operation for Administrator, Runner and Support (sandbox) accounts.

3. Cross-application interworking

- Holdings → Currency: acquiring an item draws a currency pool down; disposing adds back and flips the item to 'disposed'.
- Currency → Benefits: a benefit is funded from a chosen pool; paying or reimbursing a recipient draws that pool down.
- Family → Benefits: people are tagged with benefit groups; the Recipients view matches people to the benefits they inherit and projects annual cost.
- Unified activity timeline, alerts, statements and backups span the applications a customer has unlocked.

4. Languages & platforms

English, French, Spanish, German, Portuguese, Korean, Chinese, Japanese, Arabic (RTL), Swahili, Yoruba, Russian, Hindi, Urdu (RTL) and Tagalog. Downloadable PDF user manuals are provided per application, localised, and include the applicable terms.

5. Licensing & activation (overview)

- Each installed instance is activated by a unique 20-character, case-sensitive code.
- A code is bound to the customer's email and phone and to the target operating system.
- Activation codes are released only to verified, paid customers; a self-service retrieval flow re-delivers a paid code to the customer's own email and phone.
- Recovery on a new machine disables the prior installation of the same device class.

6. Service & maintenance (overview)

An annual service and maintenance subscription covers software updates and patches, the newsletter, and customer support (profile maintenance, usage guidance and troubleshooting). It is billed per customer account. Applicable tax is calculated at checkout based on the customer's location.

7. Security & privacy posture

Stated at a claims level; implementation detail is confidential and available to qualified parties under a non-disclosure agreement.

- Every sign-in uses multi-factor authentication (email or SMS one-time codes); new devices and new locations raise an alert.
- Role-based access control separates Administrator, Runner and Support (sandbox) duties.
- Passwords are stored only as salted one-way hashes; sensitive verification fields are encrypted at rest.
- Brute-force lockout, administrator connection blocking and session revocation protect accounts.
- Data is transmitted over encrypted connections (HTTPS/TLS) with hardened security response headers.
- Customers own their data: local and cloud backup/restore is offered, and cloud backups are uploaded by the customer to their own storage — the vendor never brokers that copy.
- Activity is auditable; administrators receive delivery-health and security alerts.
